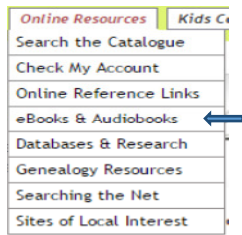
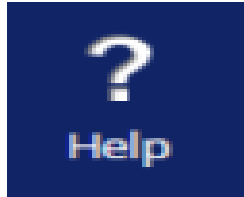


# Getting Started with eBooks at the Smiths Falls Public Library: for computers and non-WiFi enabled eReaders



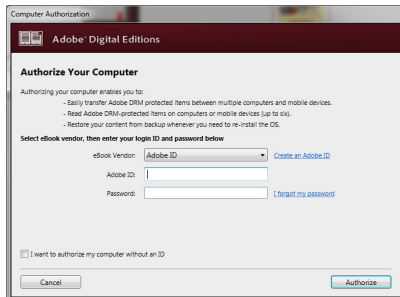
## Setting up Overdrive

To access the Overdrive Website go to the Library's website: [www.smithsfallslibrary.ca](http://www.smithsfallslibrary.ca). Click on the "Online Resources" link and choose "eBooks & Audiobooks" from the drop down menu. Click on the "browse the OverDrive Digital Library" link.



## Installing Adobe Digital Editions

You will need to download a free copy of Adobe Digital Editions 4.0.1. Click on the 'Help' icon and then the "Applications" link on the new page. Choose "Adobe Digital Editions" from the list. In the new window select "Download". Under Adobe Digital Editions 4.0.1 Installers select "windows" following Download Digital Edition 4.0.1. Complete the setup process.



**Note:** When you are going through the setup process make sure to have the " Associate .acsm and .epub file types" box checked.

Before you can download eBooks you need to Authorize your computer. After installing, Adobe Digital Editions will automatically start. Click on "help" and then "authorize computer". If you do not have an Adobe ID, click on "Create an Adobe ID" and complete the set up process. Once completed or if you already have an Adobe ID, log in to authorize your computer.

To sign in, please type your library's name and select it from the list.

## Overdrive: borrowing & downloading eBooks

Sign in to the Overdrive system by clicking on the "sign in" link at the top right corner. Type or select Smiths Falls Public Library from the list of participating libraries. Enter your library card number and click on "sign in".

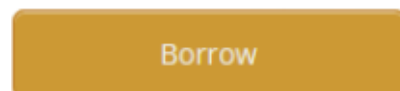
**Note:** you must include the full ten characters – PATR plus six digits. Only patrons in good standing will be able to access the Overdrive system.

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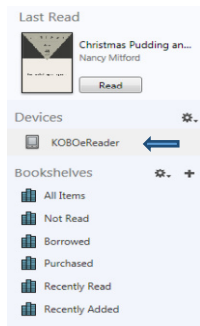


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
